Terms and Conditions

1. About :

In conjunction with Malaysia Day, Dong Zong will cooperate Selangor and Kuala Lumpur Photography Association to organize photography competition to show the multi-cultural outlook and spirit of Malaysia through photography as to maintain multi-cultural values, understand and tolerate cultural differences.

2. Purpose :

- 2.1. Promote multicultural values, social respect and tolerance.
- 2.2. Maintain the symbol of our country's diverse ethnic groups and culture.

7. Eligibility :

- 7.1. Open for Malaysian and Non-Malaysian aged 23 and below.
- 7.2. Members of organiser staff, members of co-organiser, immediate family member are not eligible to participate.
- 7.3. Contestant can submit multiple entries. However, each contestant can only win a maximum of 1 prizes.

Portray Malaysia’s culture diversity and ethnic integration by showing the moment inter-ethnic interaction, especially during the COVID-19 pandemic, as to reflect the spirit of “COVID-19: Embrace Diversity”. Any altered and plagiarized works are strictly prohibited.
