 - 3.4 Commerce : Business Studies, Bookkeeping and Accounts, Accounting, Economics
 - 3.5 Technical : Art & Graphic Design, Food & Beverage Management, Electrical and Electronics, Car Repair and Maintenance
 - 3.6 Art Knowledge : Fine Arts, Music, Computer & Information Technology, Physical Exercise and Health, Technology and Living, Performing Arts and Living

 - 5.4 Each participant can submit only ONE copy of a personal lesson plan and/or ONE copy of a collaborative lesson plan.
 - 5.5 The citation should be made accordingly (includes videos, PPTs, lesson plans, articles, exercises, etc) to avoid intellectual property infringement.
